<p>Introduction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> There was not a quorum of good standing members and therefore, the approval of minutes and CoC board elections are postponed to the next meeting with a quorum. <p>Updates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Funding Process/VHSP Collaborative Application <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The CoC has approved the new funding process and used it for the first time with the most recent VHSP application submitted at the end of March. All application materials are still posted to the CoC website for review. Coordinated Entry Process <ul style="list-style-type: none"> As part of the VHSP application, the CoC has accepted an application to create a 	

centralized coordinated entry. The grant would start in July and more details will be shared with the full CoC as they are decided on in the upcoming months.

- **Unsheltered Homeless Initiative**

- Over the past few months, Kate Gibson has been presenting the initiative to the counties and City to gain support for the funding. In February, Kate Gibson presented to the GWRC board, who was not favorable in the funding of the initiative. However, the City has added some funds into their budget for the project and is in discussion with the CoC about how those funds could be used. Also, the Mary Washington Hospital Foundation is considering committing some funds as well. As details are confirmed, CoC staff will update full CoC membership.
